

CITY COUNCIL PROCEEDINGS

May 20, 2002

The Mayor and City Council of the City of David City, Nebraska met in open public session at 5:30 p.m. on May 20, 2002 in the meeting room of the City Office, 557 4th Street, David City, Nebraska. The Public had been advised of the meeting by publication of notice in The Banner-Press on May 16th, 2002 and an affidavit of the publisher is on file in the office of the City Clerk. The Mayor and members of the City Council acknowledged advance notice of the meeting by signing the Agenda which is a part of these minutes. The advance notices to the Public, Mayor and Council members conveyed the availability of the Agenda, which was kept continuously current in the office of the City Clerk and was available for public inspection during regular office hours. No new items were added to the agenda during the twenty-four hours immediately prior to the opening of the Council meeting.

Present for the meeting were: Mayor Stephen Smith, Council members Mark Kirby, Gary Kroesing, Gary Smith, Bill Schatz, Ted Lukassen, and Nick Hein, City Administrator Andrew Brannen, and City Clerk Joan E. Kovar. Also present were Lonnie Davis, Don Hilger, Bill Kozisek, Max Birkel, city employees Gary Janicek and Mick Shipley, and Sherri Nun of the Banner Press.

The City's current health insurance plan is the CPN/CPI 401 with United Healthcare. The City was notified that to keep our current level of coverage would cost the city an additional \$38,385 an increase of 32.4%. At the May 8th council meeting the Council decided that the CPN/CPI 401 was no longer an option due to the 32.4% increase. City Administrator Andrew Brannen met with the city employees and explained that the CPN/CPI 401 was no longer an option. The city employees prefer the CPN/CPI 451.
